Ministry Internship

I. Overview

The purpose of the GCC Ministry Internship is to give individuals firsthand ministry experience in planning, development, and execution of church related activities.

II. Qualifications

Individuals desiring to participate in the Ministry Internship must meet the following guidelines in order to be eligible to apply.

- Must be a professing and practicing Christian
- 16 to 25 years old
- Flexible schedule to allow ministry expectations
- Support the Vision, Mission, and Values of Grace Collective Church
- Attend NEXT meeting.

III. Expectations

- Fulfill job requirements as stated in Ministry Internship job description.
- Complete full term of internship (Aug. 19 – May 4)
- Exemplify a God-honoring lifestyle in personal and professional areas.
- Cooperative attitude, prompt, organized, manage time well.

IV. Schedule

The Ministry Internship will begin on Monday, August 19, 2019, and conclude Monday, May 4, 2020. Weekly hours will vary department to department, and week to week. Time off for holidays and calendar breaks will be observed. All interns will have roles that will require them to serve on Sundays and special events. Meetings outside of weekly ministry services will be as follows:

- Biweekly intern meeting
- Monthly staff meeting
- Special Event participation

- Complete online application
- Submit one-minute video explaining your interest in becoming a Ministry Intern. (Additional videos may be required based on area of ministry.)
- Application deadline is July 1, 2019.
- Applicants will be notified by Aug. 1, 2019
- Ministry Internship Orientation will be Aug. 19, 2019

- Are Ministry Interns compensated?
 - No, but consideration will be taken to appreciate and care well for the time invested.
